Above is a snapshot of our financial position at April 30, 2024. Our income/expenses are both 7% higher than budget, resulting in a \$2,111 deficit that is very close to our expected budget. Income: General offerings have increased 13% compared to the same period last year. Expenses: We have remitted all outreach donations to our community partners and used the \$15k provincial grant (received Fall 2023 & Spring 2024) to update our building's security system.
