What is the Heating Fund Campaign?

St. Paul's relies on multiple furnaces to reliably heat various parts of our building. While the furnaces themselves are working well, we recently discovered that the pipes that distribute heat were not up to code and had to be replaced. The purpose of the Heating Fund Campaign is to raise the funds needed to cover the cost of these repairs.

This is a significant project that involved extensive work throughout the building. These repairs were urgent and forced us to draw from our savings to address them before the 2024-2025 winter heating season.

How much are we trying to raise?

Our goal is \$20,000 — the amount we had to withdraw for the necessary repairs.

Any funds collected above this specific need will be dedicated to future HVAC maintenance and repairs of furnaces, ventilation, and existing air conditioning units.

Why is this a priority for St. Paul's right now?

Maintaining our infrastructure is an essential part of offering a safe, functional, and welcoming space to everyone who walks through our doors. St. Paul's is home to many ministries and programs that need a comfortable place to meet, including:

- » Weekly services and Bible studies
- » Sunday school and nursery spaces
- » Community weddings and funerals
- » Vestry meetings
- » St. Paul's quilting circle
- » Community gatherings such as our Oktoberfest and St. Patrick's Day dinners
- » Church partners: St. Mina & St. Karas Coptic Church and Catch the Fire
- » Twelve step programs and support groups
- » Community rentals and events

This initiative will ensure that our building meets all code requirements and continues to support our many ministry efforts.
